Mark your calendars and dust off your walking shoes! The Foot Notes are back and ready to join the Walk to End Alzheimer's!



Gift in Honor of Georgia Fojtasek Goes to CMS



At a recent lunch to honor retiring President and CEO, Georgia Fojtasek, Henry Ford Allegiance Health pledged \$60,000 to local scholarships.

The scholarships are a tribute to Georgia's legacy of supporting education in School of the Arts, the Jackson community. In recognition of Fojtasek's three decades of leadership, Henry Ford Allegiance Health awarded \$10,000 to six educational scholarships.

The Jackson Symphony Orchestra Community Music School was the recipient of one of those \$10,000 gifts. This generous donation will be used to grant need-based music education scholarships to local students.

Other local organizations receiving funds include The Jackson \$10,000 each with the Area Manufacturers Association Kids' Camps, Jackson Commercial **Contractors Association** Trades Education, Jackson applicants.

Volunteers of Henry Ford Allegiance Healthcare Education Scholarship, and The Edward and Nella Fullman Scholarship for Nursing.

"My mother and father were both committed to their children's education despite their very limited resources. Supporting access to educational opportunities for children in our community is a privilege and a way to honor my parent's legacy," said Fojtasek.

All recipients will receive a lump sum of expectation of using \$1,000 per year over the next ten years to provide scholarships to qualified
